


FEEDBACK ANALYSIS

Students Feedback Report



The questionnaire covers every aspect of students related to learning experiences, Course curriculum, assessments, teaching-learning etc. Following data and figures represents the overall responses from Students question wise.

1. How do you rate the learning value (in terms of skills, Concept, Knowledges, Analytical ability)




The study shows that 23.4% of respondents are satisfied with excellent in the learning values. 31.2% are responded with very good, 41.9% rated with good and nearly 4% rated fair and poor in the learning process.

2. How do you qualify relevance of syllabus of your course in context of recent trends & developments.




17.1% students agreed about the relevance of the syllabus in terms of recent trends & development, 31.5% responded with very good, a majority of 47.8% thought that the syllabus was relevance in terms of recent development and 3.6% rated the present syllabus is fair & poor.

3. How do you rate the curriculum & syllabi of the course & depth of the course content.





4. How do you assess the relevance of learning values of Projects/assignments.





5. The entire syllabus was covered in the class.





6. How do you rate the allocation of credits and hours to your courses.




Most of the students are satisfied with the allocation of credits and hour of the courses.

7. How do you rate the communication with teachers.





8. The level of course delivery by faculty members in the class.




Most respondents 95.4% are very much satisfied with the course delivery by faculty members.

9. The level of preparedness of teachers for the classes.




Over 57.1% (21.7% rated excellent and 35.4% rated very good) agreed that teachers are well prepared for the classes which are very impactful for the classes.

10. Fairness of internal evaluation process by faculty members.





11. Timely announcement of examination results




A significant majority 50.3% agreed the satisfaction with the timely announcement of examination results.

12. Uses of ICT tools (such as projector, PPT, multimedia etc.) in the class by teachers for teaching.




18.2% of students rated excellent regarding the use of ICT in the class, a majority 71% (28% rated very good & 45% rated good) students thought fair and poor.

13. Opportunity for students to participate in internships, students exchange & field visits.




17.7% students are highly satisfied regarding students exchange & field visits. A total 71.9% students' respondents are very satisfied.

14. Opportunities for out of classrooms learning (guest lectures, seminars, workshops, value added programs, conference, competitions).



This feedback offers meaningful insights into students desire into the opportunities for out of classrooms learning.20.1% respondents rated excellent, a majority 72.6% (28% rated very good & 44.6% rated good) are very satisfied regarding out of classroom learning.

15. Overall rating of teaching-learning process in the Institution.



A significant majority 96.9% of students are highly satisfied with the overall rating of teaching-learning process. 3.1% students rated fair and poor regarding the overall rating of teaching-learning process.

Suggestions by Students:

Students mainly focused on the use of Technology in the classroom, timely conduct of classes as per Timetable and completion of course on time. They are suggesting that some of the classes should be done with ICT tools, like presentation, practical (where needed), digital boards, etc. Issues related to a smaller number of classrooms in the college are also highlighted by some of them. In addition, some students have given positive feedback regarding Teachers, college, and other factors related to their learning in Abhayapuri College.

Action taken Report

The analysis of overall feedback of students shows that majority of students are happy with overall performance of the Institution. A few students have issues regarding use of ICT in class, out of classroom learning, syllabus & curriculum, field visit and students' exchange.

All issues are discussed in the academic committee meeting and discussed the issues of feedback by students and resolved that each department should use more ICT based class, more students exchange programme in the next session.


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
