

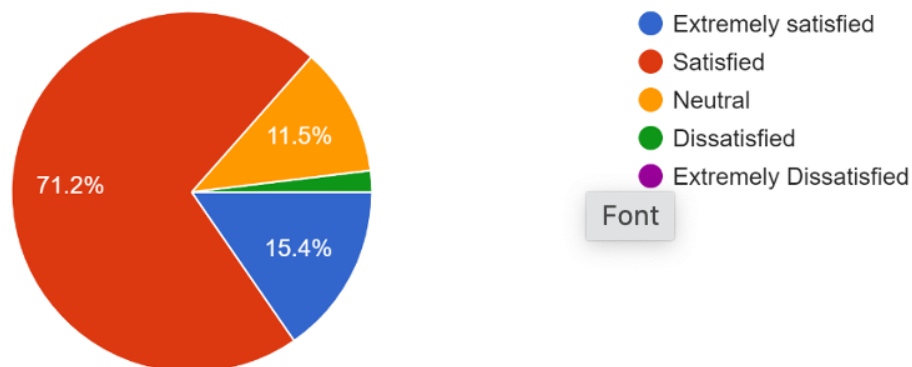

Teachers Feedback Report

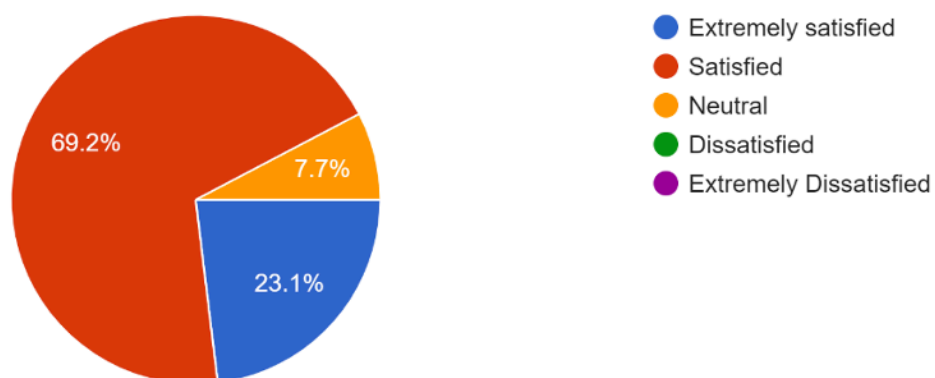
A google form is used to collect the feedback and opinion of teachers regarding the course and other college related matters.

1. Content & Relevance of the course taught.



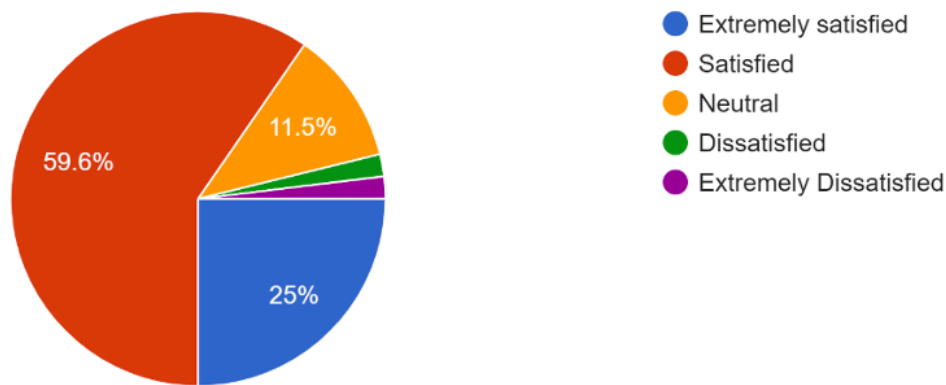
The feedback revealed that 15.4% of teachers are extremely satisfied with the content & relevance of the course, a majority 71.2% are satisfied with the course, 11.5% are neutral about the course, only 1.9% of teachers are dissatisfied with the course.

2. Flexibility. Provided in terms of mode of teaching.



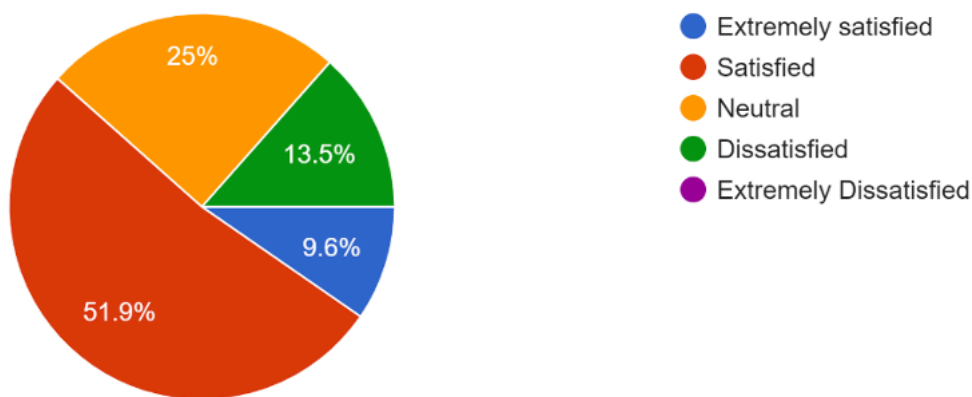
Significantly majority of respondents are highly satisfied with the flexibility provided in terms of mode of teaching.

3. Freedom provided in terms of assessments options.



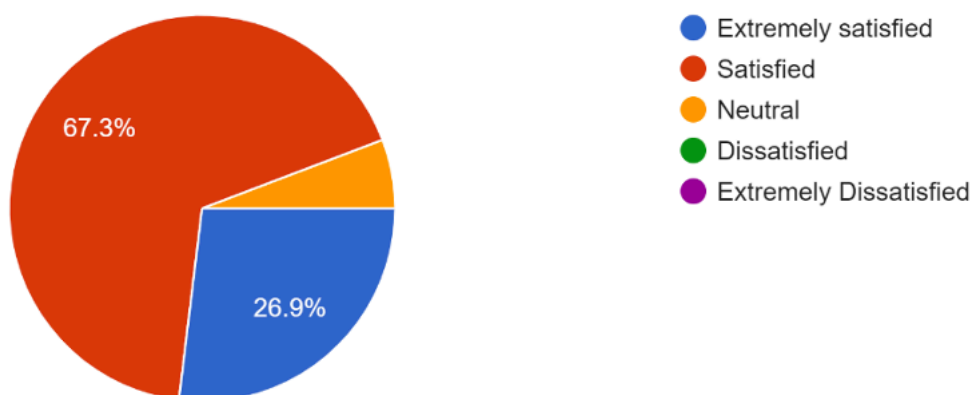

4. Support of ICT facilities within the Campus.



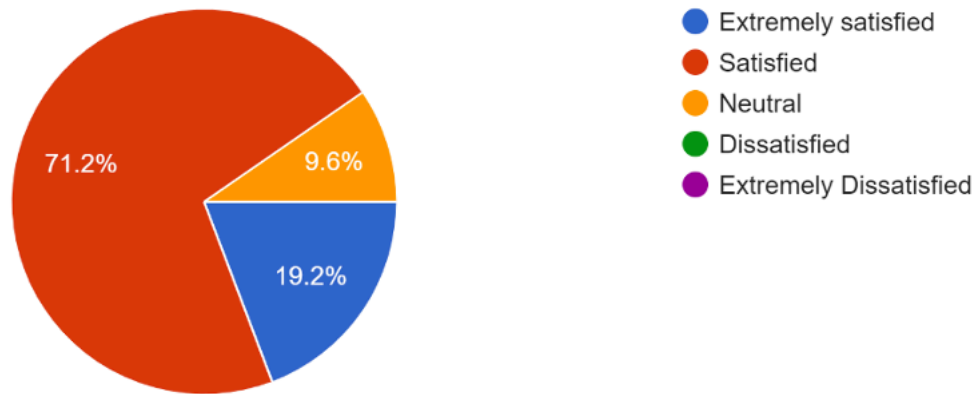

5. Provision of adequate, relevant & updated reference material in the library.



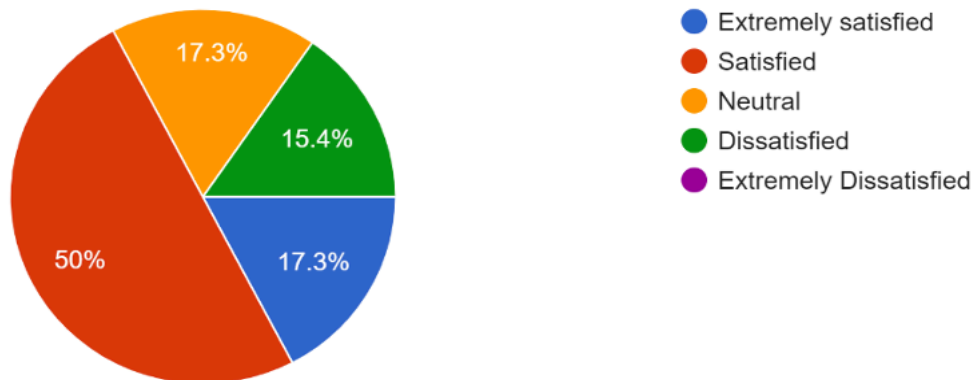
Significantly, ma majority 94.2% teachers are highly satisfied with the Library, 5.8% remain neutral.

6. Access to online resources in the library.



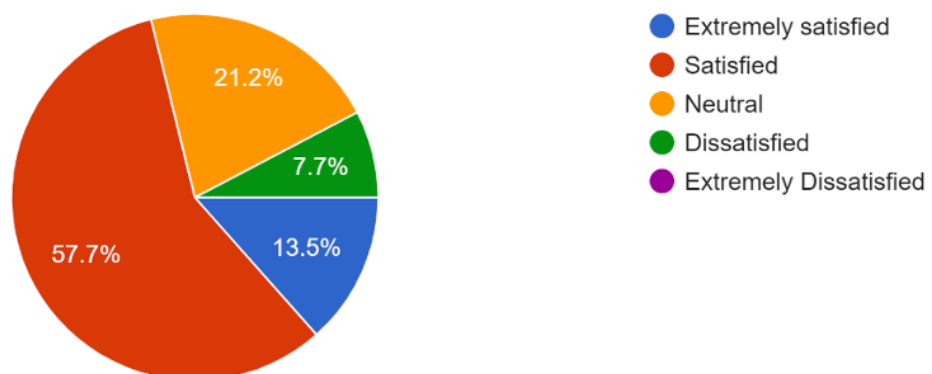
19.2% of the respondents rated extremely satisfied with the online resources in the library, 71.2% responded satisfied, 9.6% remain neutral.

7. Supply of equipment required for teaching-learning such as Laptop, Printer, Wi-fi etc.



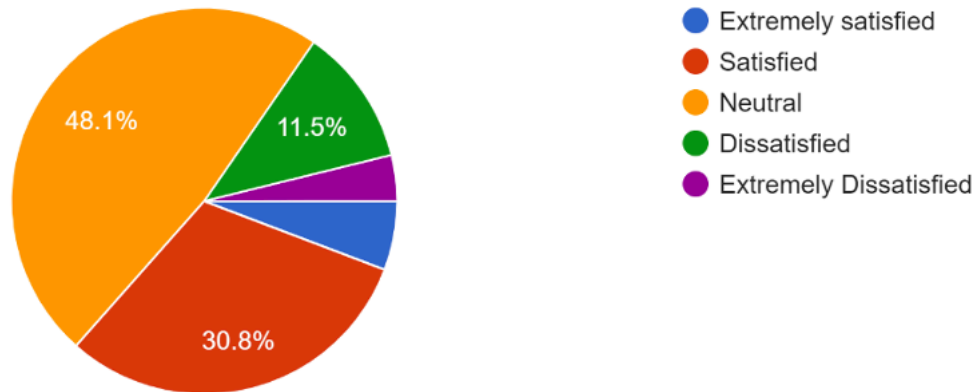

8. Enough motivation/opportunities for pursuing academic enhancement activities.



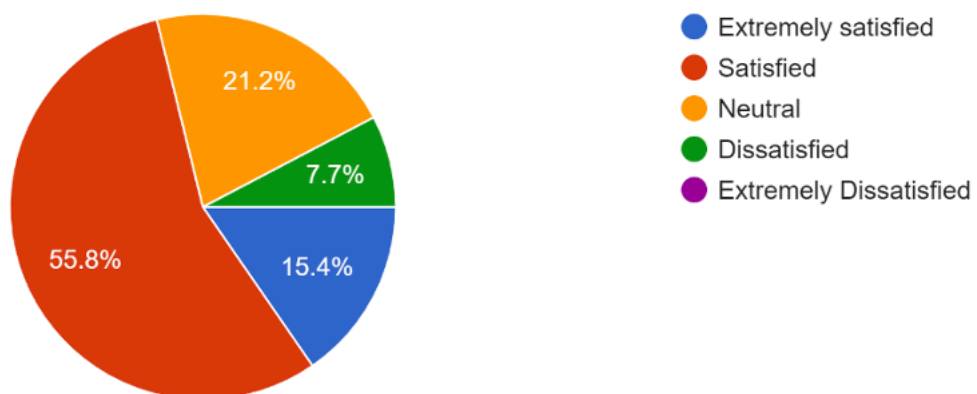

9. Financial support for upgrading skills and research activities.



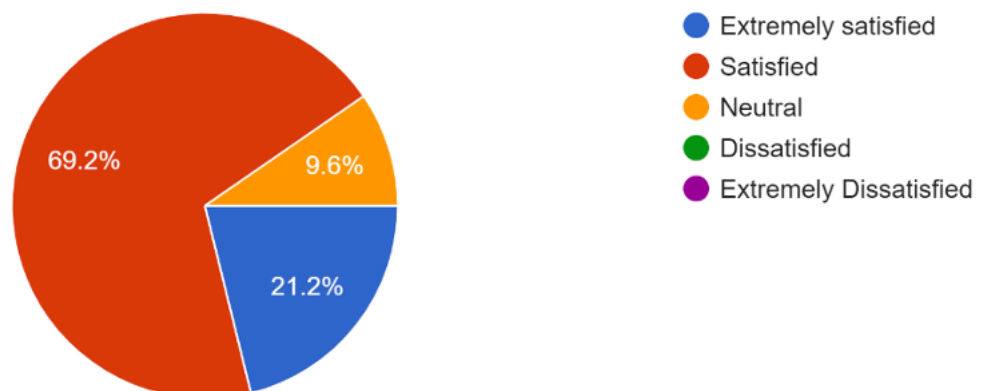
30.8% of respondents rated with satisfaction regarding financial support, majority 48.1% are neutral about it, 11.5% are dissatisfied with this.

10. Leave granted for academic endeavours.



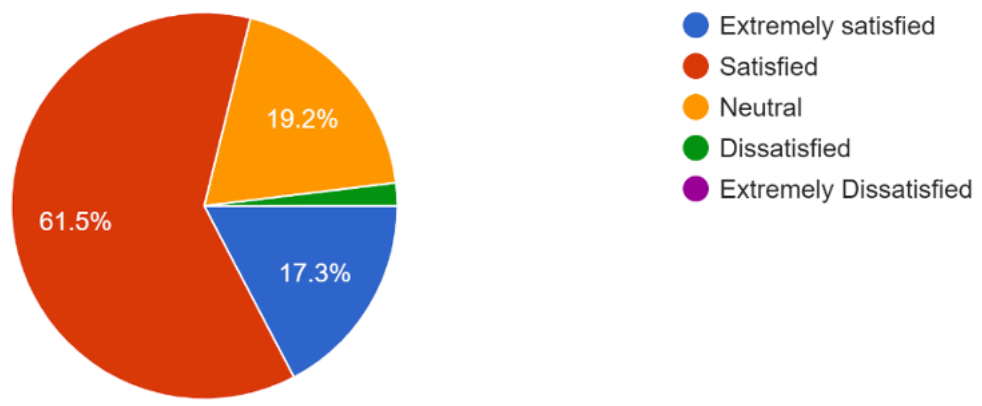

11. Encourages environment of respect and rapport among all.



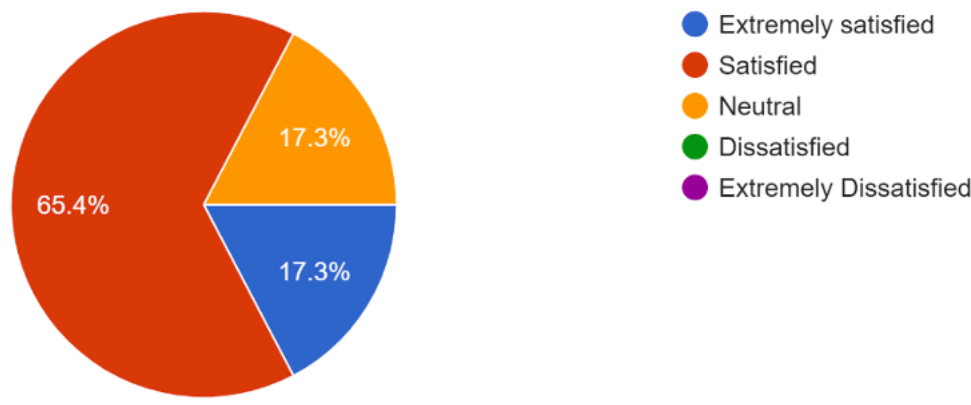
90.3% of the respondents showed their extremely satisfaction, only 9.6% remains neutral.

12. Grievance redressal mechanism for teachers.



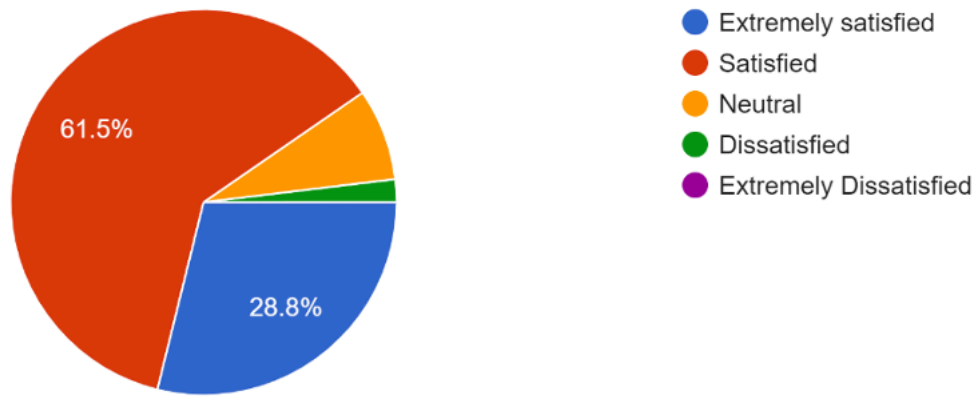
