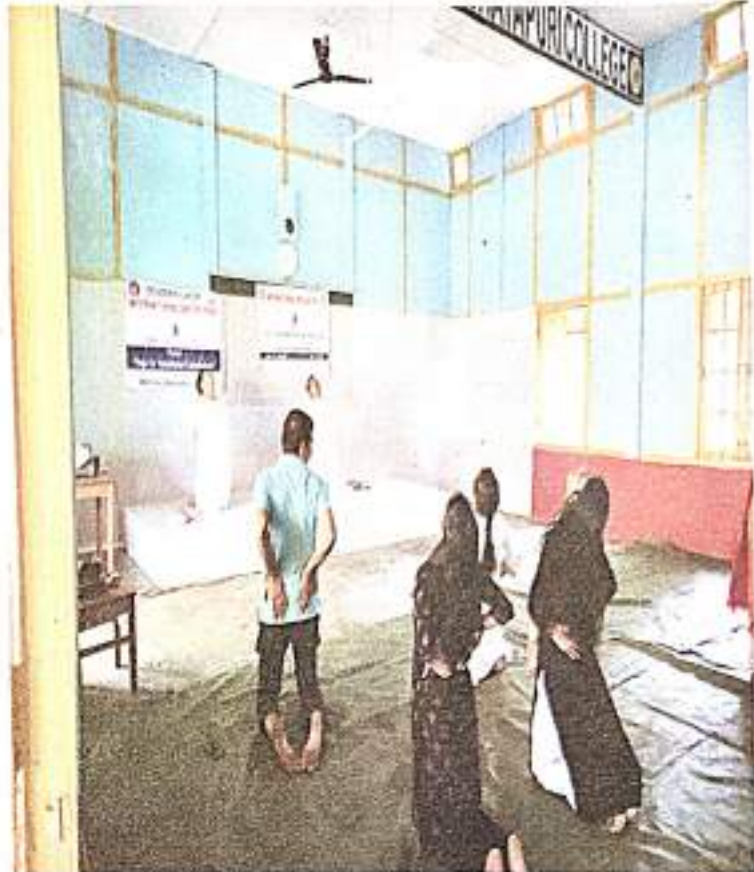
A guest speaker highlighted yoga's role in mental and physical well-being, inspiring everyone to adopt it as a daily practice.

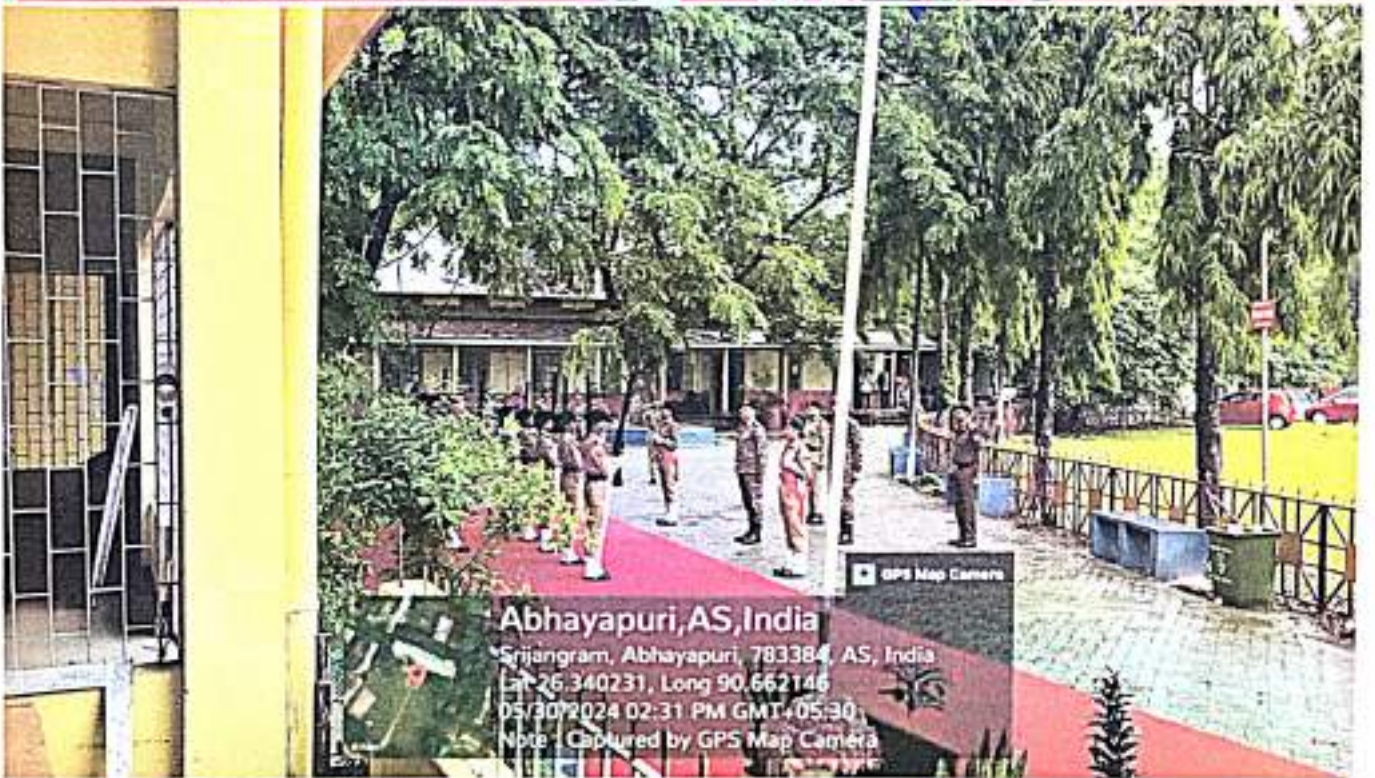
Brigadier A.K. Borah also visited to the college hostel ground where they will set up training ground and shooting range for NCC cadets.

Date: 31 May 2024

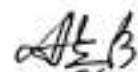
Venue: PCS Seminar Hall, Abhayapuri College
