

Extension Programmes for 2023-24

PLANTATION

Our NSS unit have undertaken plantation Drive in various places of Abhayapuri area specially in adopted villages i.e., Bhomapara and Bhatipara. Under the banner of Forest Festival we have planted around 85 saplings in college campus, college hostels, adopted villages. CLEAN INDIA CAMPAIGN 2.0

The Swachh Bharat Mission 2.0, or Clean India Campaign 2.0, is a five-year program launched in **2021** by the Indian government to make cities garbage-free by **2026**. The NSS unit Abhayapuri College actively conducted cleanliness Drive programme in different part of Abhayapuri town. The unit organized cleanliness drive in Abhayapuri CHC(FRU), the unit collected 50 KG of garbage from Haripur Lakshmi Mandir Playground soon after completion of Lakshmi Puja Mela. Our unit has also collaborated with Abhayapuri Municipal Board and Abhayapuri CHC (FRU). Mentioned may be made that one of our active volunteer Bighu Nath, have collected 15 kgs of garbage along with few villagers of Batabari. Large amount of garbage have been collected from our college campus.





WORLD BICYCLE DAY

As per the instruction of Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, the NSS unit conducted the survey twice, one at Bhomapara and Bhatipara Village (2023) and another at Bowalimari and Haripur village (2024). As per the analysis it was found that in Bhomapara and Bhatipara village majority of the male population age between 15 to 29 are not engaged in government job but are engaged as farmers and daily wage workers. Majority female of the same age group have qualification upto class 10 and engaged as self employed. As per the analysis it was found that in Bowalimari and Haripur village area majority of the population age between 15 to 29 are not engaged in government job but are engaged as business activity. Majority female of the same age group have qualification upto class 10 and engaged as self employed







The Scenario Of The Government Schemes Implementation at Bowalimari

The unit conducted a survey at Bowalimari on 28th March, 2024. As per the survey, the village has 286 persons out of the 63 Household surveyed. From the above table it is clear that majority of the Population (53 %) are farmers and only a few population (4 %) are involved in Business. 22 % of them are in Service Sector and 19 % are in Other Category. From the above table it is clear that majority of the Beneficiaries (32 %) have availed PM Awas Yojana (Rural) . 5 % of the Beneficiaries have availed the Atal Amrit Abhiyan, PM Gram Sadak Yojana and Early Children care and education, 15 % are PM Gram Sadak Yojana beneficiaries. As per the above data, it is seen that there is no beneficiaries availing MGNREG Act,2005 and Piped Water Supply Scheme.

ODISHA, 2024


Day-3, 30th March,
